Class 4 - Perennials & Other Spring Blooms

Section

1. Flowering Shrub, 1 branch
2. Bleeding Hearts, 3 stems
3. Lily, 1 stem
4. Daffodil, 3 stems
5. Tulips, 3 stems
6. Dianthus, 5 stems
7. Pansies/Violas, 5 stems
8. Other spring bloom, 3 stems

Class 5 - Miscellaneous

Section

1. Green Onions, in water, 5 onions
2. Radish, any type, 5 radishes
3. Rhubarb, Strawberry Red, 3 stalks tied
4. Rhubarb, other, 3 stalks tied
5. Herb, in a pot, not more that 15 inches in diameter (inside wall)
6. Flowering Houseplant
7. Foliage Houseplant
